WOMEN'S SHOTGUN AND TRAP SHOOTING BASICS



- This clinic is open to the public and intended for women with little or no experience with a shotgun or clay target shooting on a trap range. If you are experienced with shooting trap, skeet, five stand, or sporting clays, this introductory event may not be for you (please join us at one of our [weekly trap shoots open to the public](#)).

- Instruction will cover topics including safe firearms handling, general rules of trap shooting, course of fire, stance, eye dominance and more.

Date and Times:

- May 4, 2019 Rain or Shine
- Session 1: Starts 9:00 a. m. and runs until 11:00 a. m.
- Session 2: Starts at 12:30 p. m. and runs until 2:30 p. m.

Cost:

- \$15.00 per person (Includes instruction, 25 shotgun shells, and 25 targets)

Registration:

- Space is limited and pre-registration is required. Only pre-registered participants will be admitted (no friends, family members, onlookers, etc.).

Requirements:

- Participants must be a minimum of 18 years of age
- Participants will be required to sign a waiver/release upon arriving at the event
- Only pre-registered participants will be admitted (no friends, family members, onlookers, etc.).
- Eye protection is **required** (complementary eye protection will be available for loan at no charge)

- Hearing protection is **required** (complementary hearing protection will be provided at no charge)
- Participants should dress for the anticipated weather. This is a rain or shine event. Comfortable clothing that allows free movement of the shoulders, arms, and waist is recommended. For safety reasons, no tank tops, bikini tops, or low-cut clothing are allowed. Closed toe footwear is strongly recommended.
- Participants may bring their own shotgun
 - Shotguns must be designed to be shot from the shoulder and for sport hunting or sport target shooting (no military/law enforcement, no sawed off stocks, no sawed off barrels, etc.)
 - Shotguns must be 12 or 20 gauge
 - A **limited number** of 12 gauge and 20 gauge shotguns will be available for loan (no charge) to participants who do not bring their own
